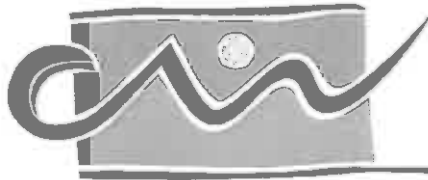

**This COA is issued subject to the following conditions:**

1. The certificate of acceptability is issued subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) the milking shed may at any reasonable time be inspected;
  - (b) staff employed at the milking shed and dairy stock may at any reasonable time be inspected or examined by an inspector; and
  - (c) the milking shed must be used in accordance with the provisions of GNR.961 of 23 NOVEMBER 2012;
  - (d) the certificate of acceptability shall be displayed in a conspicuous place or a copy thereof shall immediately be made available on request where the display thereof is impractical provided that a certificate of acceptability that is under suspension or withdrawal as provided for in regulation 5 shall not be displayed or made available;
  - (e) the certificate of acceptability shall not be transferable from one person to another person and from one milking shed to another milking shed;
  - (f) the certificate of acceptability shall be valid only in respect of the structure and nature of handling set out in the application for a certificate of acceptability;
  - (g) the certificate of acceptability may at any time be endorsed by a local authority by -
    - (i) the addition of any further restriction that may be necessary to prevent a health hazard; and
    - (ii) the removal of any restriction with regard to the method of handling;
  - (h) the certificate of acceptability shall expire temporarily for the period during which a prohibition under sub-regulation 2(3) is in effect
  - (i) the certificate of acceptability shall expire permanently if a prohibition referred to in sub-regulation 2(3) is not removed within a stipulated period which shall not exceed six months from the date on which a notice was issued in terms of sub-regulation 2(3);
  - (j) the certificate of acceptability shall expire permanently if the provisions of sub-regulation 2(3) are not complied with
2. No person may make any unauthorized changes or additions to or forge a certificate of acceptability.
3. If the holder of a milking shed is replaced by another person, such person shall inform the local authority in writing of such replacement within 30 days after the date thereof and the local authority shall subject to the provisions of sub-regulation 2(3), issue a new certificate of acceptability in the name of the new holder.
4. Subject to the provisions of sub-regulation 4(3) and regulation 5, where applicable, a certificate of acceptability issued prior to the commencement of these regulations in terms of the regulations published in Government Notice No. R. 1256 of 27 June 1986 shall be deemed a certificate of acceptability issued in terms of these regulations.

**GNR. 961 of 23 NOVEMBER 2012 REGULATIONS RELATING TO HYGIENE REQUIREMENTS FOR MILKING SHEDS, THE TRANSPORT OF MILK AND RELATED MATTERS PROMULGATED IN TERMS OF THE FOODSTUFFS, COSMETICS AND DISINFECTANTS ACT, 1972 (ACT 54 OF 1972):**

**INSPECTION REPORT IN RELATION TO AN APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE OF ACCEPTABILITY AS CONTEMPLATED IN REGULATION 3 (5): Zandam Milking Shed**

We refer to your application for a Certificate of Acceptability for the above mentioned premises dated: 2022-04-11.

An inspection of the premises was conducted on to evaluate compliance with Regulations 6 (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and 7 of the regulation.

It was found that the premises comply with all the provision(s) of Regulation 6 (1), (2), (3), (4), (5) and 7 and you will subsequently be issued with a Certificate of Acceptability in terms of Regulation 3(6)(b).

1. The Certificate of Acceptability is issued subject to the following conditions:
  - (a) the milking shed may at any reasonable time be inspected;
  - (b) staff employed at the milking shed and dairy stock may at any reasonable time be inspected or examined by an inspector; and
  - (c) the milking shed must be used in accordance with the provisions of GNR. 961 of 23 NOVEMBER 2012;
  - (d) the Certificate of Acceptability shall be displayed in a conspicuous place or a copy thereof shall immediately be made available on request where the display thereof is impractical provided that a Certificate of Acceptability that is under suspension or withdrawal as provided for in Regulation 5 shall not be displayed or made available;

  - (g) the Certificate of Acceptability may at any time be endorsed by a local authority by -
    - (i) the addition of any further restriction that may be necessary to prevent a health hazard; and
    - (ii) the removal of any restriction with regard to the method of handling;
  - (h) the Certificate of Acceptability shall expire temporarily for the period during which a prohibition under Sub-Regulation 2(3) is in effect
  - (i) the Certificate of Acceptability shall expire permanently if a prohibition referred to in Sub-Regulation 2(3) is not removed within a stipulated period which shall not exceed six months from the date on which a notice was issued in terms of Sub-Regulation 2(3);
  - (j) the Certificate of Acceptability shall expire permanently if the provisions of Sub-Regulation 2(3) are not complied with
2. No person may make any unauthorized changes or additions to or forge a Certificate of Acceptability.
  3. If the holder of a milking shed is replaced by another person, such person shall inform the local authority in writing of such replacement within 30 days after the date thereof and the local authority shall subject to the provisions of Sub-Regulation 2(3), issue a new Certificate of Acceptability in the name of the new holder.
  4. Subject to the provisions of Sub-Regulation 4(3) and Regulation 5, where applicable, a Certificate of Acceptability issued prior to the commencement of these regulations in terms of the regulations published in Government Notice No. R. 1256 of 27 June 1986 shall be deemed a Certificate of Acceptability issued in terms of these regulations.
